## "Board Responsibilities Regarding the Approval of Planned Additions and Alterations to the Exterior of Homes and Property"

- 1. When notified by the home owner(s) or Essex Town Hall, a representative of the Southwinds Association, Inc. board shall meet with the home owner(s) to:
  - (a) briefly review plans that require a zoning variance and/or building permit regarding the addition or alternation to the exterior of the owner's home and/or property to make sure such plans are consistent with relevant sections of Southwinds Association, Inc. covenants; and
  - (b) verify that home owners who live adjacent to their property have been informed.
- 2. Upon review, the designated representative of the board shall submit his/her recommendations to the Board for approval.

Pursuant to Article III. Section 10\* (Action by Consent in Lieu of a Meeting) of Amended and Restated By-Laws, the Southwinds Association, Inc. Board, via e-mail review and reply, approved the above stated procedure on June 27, 2019 as follows:
